5. The meal plan and eating options:

We don't have a meal plan for dorm residents. However, there are several options to eat:

1. Students can cook their own meals in public kitchens which are located in dorm facilities
2. The high school will allow us to eat with them for Breakfast and Lunch in the Machebeuf Cafeteria Monday-Friday if their school is open. (They are closed on American holidays.), during the times listed below.
